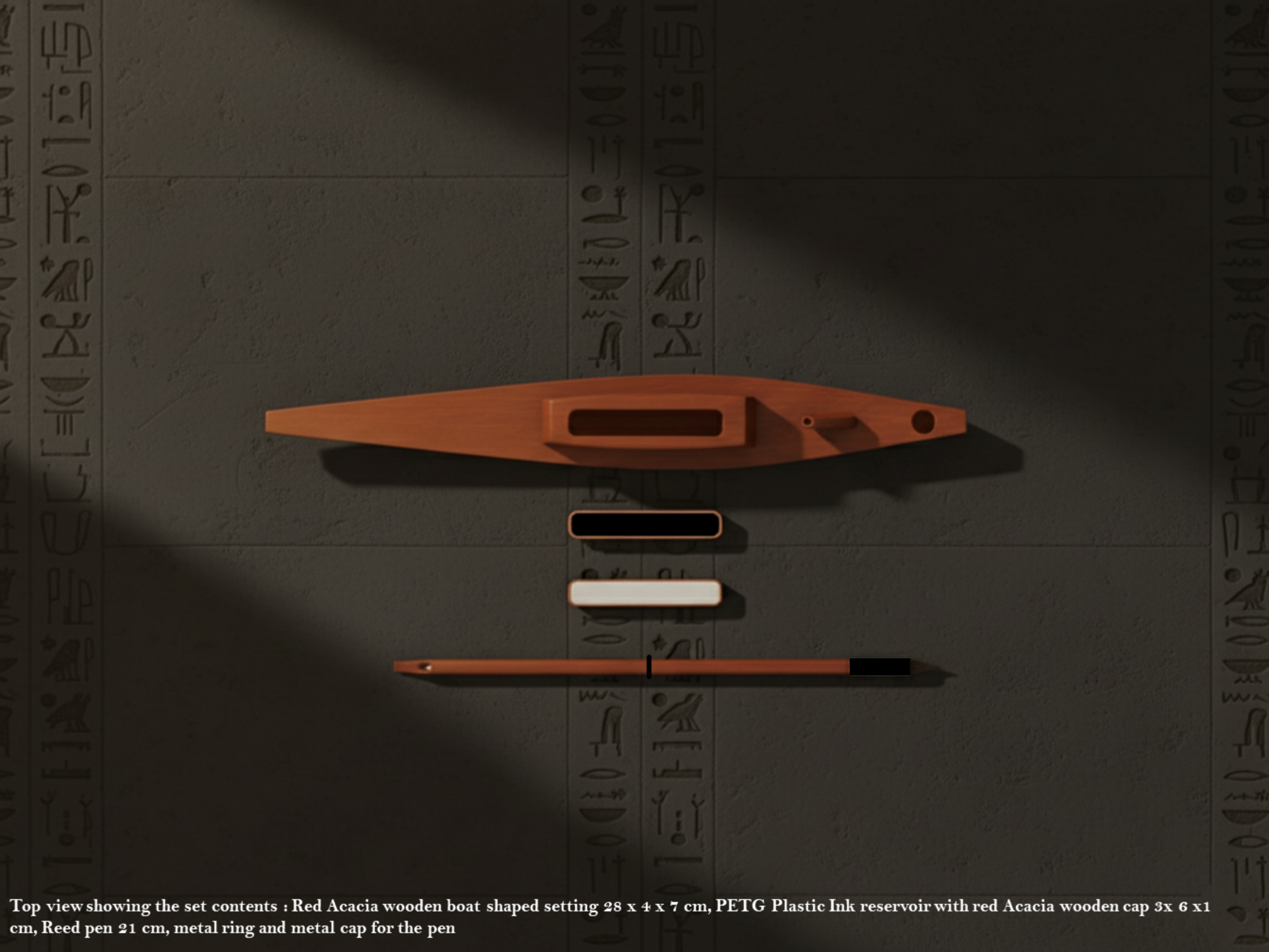


QALAM EL KHOLOUD



Calligraphy set inspired from the Ancient Egyptian boats



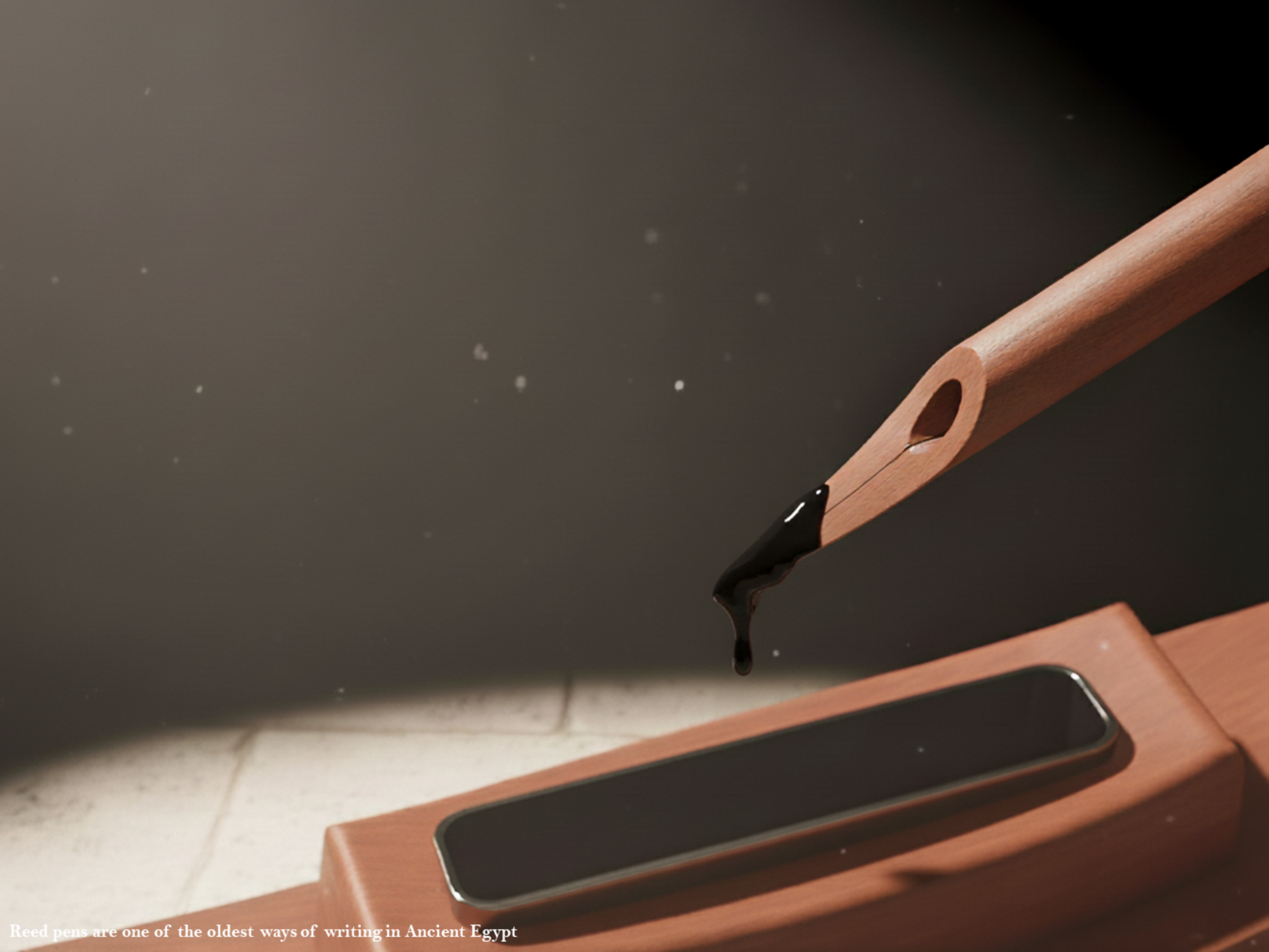

The small wooden lever help in holding the pen in position by attaching metal ring around it and the small lever contains small magnet



The small wooden arm helps to secure the pen in place to prevent ink from spilling around.



Reed pens are one of the oldest ways of writing in Ancient Egypt



Using the preserved old Egyptian method of calligraphy in a modern way
